

BCLM Rally Equipment Stable Management Setup

GROOM

Required for Stable Management (SM)

- PC Passport
- PC pin and disc
- ASTM helmet within the last 5 years
- Gloves
- Baseball cap or visor
- Paddock boots
- Conservative, respectful non-riding attire (mid-length shorts, no crop tops, etc)
- Hairnets & bobby pins

Other items for Camping or Optional for SM

- Alarm clock
- Loonies for showers
- All personal clothing for weather
- Bathing suit, towels, toiletries
- Sunscreen, bug spray
- Lawn chair
- Camping equipment
- Dishes / cutlery for camping meals
- Mug / cup for hot drinks (i.e. Mug up)
- Water bottle
- Rubber boots

CAPTAIN

Required for Stable Management (SM)

- PC Passport
- PC pin and disc
- ASTM helmet within the last 5 years
- Baseball cap or visor
- Gloves
- Hairnets & bobby pins
- Apron or bucket/grooming bag
- Paddock boots
- Conservative, respectful non-riding attire (mid-length shorts, no crop tops, etc)
- Riding boots and show attire (if riding in Captains Jump Round)

Other items for Camping or Optional for SM

- Alarm clock
- Loonies for showers
- All personal clothing for weather
- Bathing suit, towels, toiletries
- Sunscreen, bug spray
- Lawn chair
- Camping equipment

RIDER

Required for Stable Management (SM)

- PC Passport
- PC pin and disc
- ASTM helmet within the last 5 years
- Baseball cap or visor
- Paddock boots
- Boot inserts for tall leather boots
- Boot jack- if you need one (i.e. tall boots do not have zippers)
- Hairnets & bobby pins
- Conservative, respectful non-riding attire (mid-length shorts, no crop tops, etc)

Other items for Camping or Optional for SM

- Alarm clock
- Loonies for showers
- All personal clothing for weather
- Baseball cap or visor
- Bathing suit, towels, toiletries
- Sunscreen, bug spray

- Garment bag with your show clothes (preference is to keep it at campsite):**

Formal show attire:

- Show coat
- White blouse (not sleeveless)
- Show Shirt (if worn without coat, must have short or long sleeves)
- Breeches (beige/white) - 2 pairs if available
- Riding boots or smooth leather half chaps (colour matching paddock boot)
- Gloves (black/brown/tan/white)

XC riding attire:

- Long or short sleeved shirt
- Breeches (any colour)
- XC Protective Vest (certified for competition)
- Gloves (any colour)

Optional riding equipment:

- Armband
- PC crest on show coat (on left sleeve)
- Protective Air Vest
- Extra breeches for schooling
- Spurs
- XC watch

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TACK ROOM

Required Equipment for Stable Management (SM)

Per Horse:

- Complete grooming kit for each horse (D Teams: D2 level, ABC Teams: B level)
- Dressage saddle (if used) - in good repair
- Jumping saddle - in good repair
- Girths - in good repair
- Bridle - in good repair
- Saddle pads- dressage, jumping, xc
- Splint boots, bell boots

Per Team:

- Whips - dressage and jumping, lungeing if needed
- Equine First Aid kit (with set of Stable Bandages)
- Human First Aid kit
- Clean rub rags
- Fly spray
- Showsheen / body conditioner
- Horse shampoo
- Sweatscraper
- Braiding elastics, comb, yarn, scissors
- Leather hole puncher
- Strong wool/binder twine - to tie in bridle for xc
- Boot polish
- Wet wipes
- Hoof oil
- Safety pins
- Tack Cleaning Kit
- Spare leathers
- Spare set of reins
- Spare halter and lead rope
- Binder twine
- Scissors

Printed materials:

- PC Manuals
- Rally Policies & Procedures and EC rules
- Trot-up/cool-out procedures
- Rally FAQ
- Dressage tests
- XC Courses
- Captains time schedule, riders time schedules
- Team poster / Captain & Groom posters

Hardware:

- garbage can
- mirror
- clock
- bulletin board / push pins
- Bridle rack/hooks
- Saddle racks
- Book shelf
- Hooks for helmets
- Drink Cooler

Optional Equipment for SM

Per Horse:

- Fly bonnet
- Fly mask
- Breastplate
- Martingale
- Horse's day sheet, fly sheet, night sheet
- Cooler - dependant on weather
- Stable bandages - if using

Per Team:

- Theme décor
- Extra halter and lead
- Duct tape
- Additional horse care reference books
- Small bucket with sand (for fire safety)
- Liniment - if using
- Tape - for bridle buckles and splint boots - if using
- Spare girth
- Spare bridle
- Spare horse boots
- Lunge line
- Tail bandage
- No Smoking Sign
- small table
- chairs
- hooks to hang aprons (aprons are optional)
- Whip holder
- 4 prong hook for cleaning tack
- Hooks for girths
- Saddle pad rack

Required TACK ROOM Setup for Stable Management (SM)

On Bulletin board: SM papers, dressage tests, trot-up/cool-out procedures, xc courses, captains time schedule, riders time schedules

On Shelf: library of manuals/books/binders with printed rules, etc.

Tack cleaning hook thrown over ceiling rafter for cleaning bridles

Groom pail/apron: show sheen, hoof oil, baby wipes, rub rags, scissors, fly spray, water for rider, horse brush / tail comb anything else you want in there

Girths get hung beside saddles on a single nail by saddle, or can be over saddle if clean and placed properly

Helmets hang on wall hooks

Bridles / martingales hung on wall hooks

All tall riding boots lined up with inserts to make them stand up (or note that grooms are wearing paddock boots)

Labelling only of items:

- that need to be known to who it belongs (i.e. participant# for tack, helmet, bins, etc.)

- that need identify where to store/find equipment (i.e. drawer for rags, first aid kits (if tucked away.)

Optional Setup for SM

Dressing room area inside tack room

Curtains for front of tack room

Garment bags hung on wall hooks - prefer to remain in camp

BCLM Rally Equipment Stable Management Setup

FEED ROOM

Required Equipment for Stable Management (SM)

Per Horse:

- Hay - appropriate amount
- Grain for each feeding - labeled in separate zip lock bags
- Bin with lid to hold bagged grain, succulents, supplements
- Feed tub/bucket (bucket with lid/cover if soaking food)
- Feed schedule/poster (with rider #)

Per Team:

- Fire extinguisher
- No smoking sign
- Safety rules posted beside Fire extinguisher
- Huge tarp or hay bags to wrap up under/around all bales so no hay is showing
- 1 wheelbarrow
- 1 broom
- 1 shovel
- 2 shavings forks
- hooks to hang tools (shovel, broom, etc.)
- a feed scale
- hay-net
- fire extinguisher (with rules & no smoking sign posted beside it)

Cool-out equipment:

- 2-3 big tubs
- 1 small tarp
- 1 saddle rack
- multiple sponges - big and small
- 2 sweat scrapers
- Team sign with Team # for cool out location

Optional Equipment for SM

Per Horse:

- Supplements (if used)
- Medications (if used) must be stored in the Show Office

Per Team:

- Drying rack to dry wet splint and bell boots on

Required FEED ROOM Setup for Stable Management (SM)

- Have hay-net neatly tied to feed scale
- Post rules & no smoking sign beside fire extinguisher
- Post feed schedules above respective hay bales/feed
- Hang tools on wall hooks
- Labelling only of items:**
 - that need to be known to who it belongs (i.e. participant# for grain, etc.)
 - that need identify where to store/find equipment (i.e. drawer for rags, etc.)

Optional SETUP for SM

- Curtains (optional) to hang in front of feed room

STALL (per Horse)

Required Equipment for Stable Management (SM)

- Stall guard
- Water buckets
- Halter hook
- Hardware for buckets, stall guard, haynet, etc.
- Bailing twine
- Horse/Rider poster
- Bedding (supplied by facility)

Optional Equipment for SM

- Hay net (optional)

Required STALL SETUP for Stable Management (SM)

- Have adequate bedding in stall
- Post Horse/Rider poster outside stall
- Ensure bailing twine is used when mounting haynets
- Halter hook mounted outside the stall
