## **ACCEPTANCE OF RISK FORM (WAIVER OF LIABILITY)**

**THIS DOCUMENT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES.  
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.**

Every entry at the Central Ontario Region Dressage Clinic shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, and the horse shall be subject to the Constitution and the Rules of the Canadian Pony Club, OEF, Equestrian Canada, and that every horse, rider, and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree to hold the clinician, Canadian Pony Club, OEF, Equine Canada, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken.

I acknowledge that any activity involving horses is high risk including but not limited to:

- a) the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and to potentially collide with, bit or kick other animals, people or objects;
- b) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, tremors, vibrations, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals and hazards such as subsurface objects;
- c) the potential for other participants to behave in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to themselves or others, including failing to act within their abilities to maintain control over an equine.

The laws of Ontario and the rules of Equestrian Canada require that Junior competitors wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while. Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) standards and displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable. It is understood that if the competitor does not meeting this requirement that s/he will not be allowed to ride at this clinic.

I recognize that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. Neither the Canadian Pony Club, host Pony Club(s), Staff, Organizers, Property Owners nor any person acting on their behalf, shall be held liable for any loss, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
