Some of you who watch the PC calendar will have noticed already the date for the conformation clinic. I will include some more info on that clinic with this notice.

There will also be a nutrition lecture, calculating horse weight, horse feed calculations, how to body score on Saturday, October 14th from 10:00 to 12:00. The location will be announced at a later date.

It will involve working with horses at the facility so proper gear will be required.



A St John's Ambulance First Aid course has been set up for November 11th and 12th at the Barrie office. They are offering us a 10% discount there. The Standard First Aid will be both days from 8:30 to 4:30. The cost will be \$148.50 (regular \$165.)

The first day will also offer an Emergency First Aid for any who wish just that one. The cost will be \$108.00 (regular \$120)
