



The Barbara Grimm COR Volunteer of the Year AWARD

Barbara was a long standing branch, regional and national volunteer with the Canadian Pony Club who passed away March 11, 2014. She started with the Tynedale PC in the Central Ontario Region in the mid 1980's when her two girls, Heather and Kathleen, joined the branch. She was very active in all club activities and especially PPG across the region. She held numerous positions throughout the years including Regional Secretary, Membership and Visiting Commissioner for COR. She was also the CPC National Secretary and the first National Chair for Disciplines. She contributed to the organization of so many events in years past including the yearly PPG competitions at the CNE, the Ontario Pony Club's Tournament of Champions (OPTOC) and, lastly, the CPC 75th Anniversary Celebration in 2009. For her volunteerism and dedication, Barb was voted an Honourary Lifetime Member by the National Board of Directors and is listed on the CPC Wall of Achievement.

The nominations for the award may be made by any branch within the Region for an adult volunteer member of the club who is not an active CPC member. The recipient will be a volunteer who best meets the ideals of Pony Club in his/her volunteerism in the support of their members during the current year. There is a trophy with a plate with the recipient's name engraved upon it to be held for one year. The winner may also be presented with a commemorative keeper gift. Each branch, within the Central Ontario Region, can submit a nomination form. A Regional committee will select the most worthy nomination. The award will be presented at the COR Awards Banquet or at the COR AGM.
