Central Ontario Region Pony Club Horse Masters

Pony Club Horsemasters Program was developed to meet the needs of parents and other adults to learn more about horses, to feel comfortable around them and secure in their knowledge about horsemanship and riding skills and to share their knowledge with active members.

Horsemasters groups may be formed in affiliation with a Pony Club Branch, Riding Centre within the Region...***

Open to adults over 21 prior to Jan 1 of the year in which they become a member.

MAY NOT be both an Active Member and a Horsemasters member at the same time.

Must be an OEF member

Must pay Branch, Regional and National fees set out by the Branch, Region and National

Members will have access to lessons, clinics, camps and competitions hosted by a Branch or COR Region (Mounted or Unmounted)

HM members are expected to give back to Central Ontario Region Pony Club with volunteer hours

Testing will not be offered for first year of the pilot project. HM are encouraged to learn as much as they want about a particular topic.

It is not necessary to ride to become a HM

** *HM* will be branch and regional members

Branches are encouraged to make available to HM members to any activities deemed appropriate.

HM will NOT compete against active members in competition, but will compete in an HM division as an open class entry... This class may be integrated with a class of Active members but MUST be pinned separately.

HM may conduct lessons clinics and competitions but must invite active COR members.

HM may conduct fundraising for their own use as they deem necessary.

Must abide by all of National and Central Ontario Rules and Guidelines.

Must remain a member in good standing for the duration of their yearly membership.
