Canadian Pony Club National Rally Information:

National Rally is being held for the first time with new format and this is your chance to be a part of it!

Dates: July 31 – August 3, 2014

Location: Twisted Pine Farm, Ayr, Ontario

Levels: Competition at National Rally will be at the Entry, Pre-Training and Training levels. Training Level will depend on number of entrants & horses available. SLOV, COR and WOR are expected to provide a horse for the pool. Competition rules will be Equine Canada Eventing Rules and CPC National Rally Rules 2014 (downloadable from the CPC website). Captains and Grooms can be C and above, Riders C and above.

Teams:

Regions can submit a full team or submit names for Scramble Teams. Teams can be mixed levels. A team consists of 2 riders, 1 groom and 1 Captain.

Horses:

- Horses will arrive by noon on Thursday July 31.
- There will be a matching session starting at 2:00 pm where riders and horses will be picked for one another. You will get to meet the owners and a trainer who will watch and approve the rider-horse combination. All riders will be given a flat lesson on Thursday. All riders will be given a jumping/cross country lesson on Friday.
- The owner will supply the feed, tack and instructions; you will feed, care for, exercise and groom the horse and clean and maintain the tack throughout the competition.
- Horses will be taken home in the afternoon of Saturday, August 2nd and it will be your responsibility to ensure that your borrowed mount and equipment are returned to the owner in as good or better condition that when you were assigned the horse.

Stable Management:

All tack and feed stall equipment will be provided. It is up to the team to organize the tack/feed room
according to Canadian Pony Club rules. All competitors will be marked at the B Level for Stable
Management.
