

## **2014 Code For Adult Supervisors/Chaperones**

**\*\*\*\*When supervising, you must wear Supervisor badge at all times\*\*\*\***

Supervisors/Chaperones must familiarize themselves with the Rally Emergency / Fire Procedure. Please note only Safety Officer is to call 911.

Supervisors/Chaperones must introduce themselves to the teams they are supervising and be able to identify the Captain(s)

The role of the Supervisors/Chaperones is to ensure that team members have enough to eat and drink (make sure eating area is left tidy) supply sunscreen, drinks and respond to emergencies.

There is to be no interference with the teams, nor should the Supervisors be spending time in the stables except to supply snacks, drinks and sunscreen. Failure to comply could result in elimination of team.

If a Supervisor/Chaperone notices an infraction or discipline issue with a member of **any** team, the issue should be brought forward to the Rally Chair at the Show Office, where it will be determined how to handle the issue.

Supervisors/Chaperones are to escort members to and from swimming during designated swimming times ONLY. A qualified lifeguard must be present, as well as the Supervisor, at all times. Members must wear pinny except when swimming.

No dogs are allowed.

Please ensure that NO food is brought into tents.

No alcohol is to be consumed by Competitors or Chaperones at National Rally.

Officials and opponents are to be regarded and treated as honest in intention. Decisions of officials, no matter how unfair they seem, are to be accepted without appearance of vexation. The team captain (not the Supervisor/Chaperones) is to address any problems.

The rules are to be regarded as mutual agreements, the spirit or letter of which no one should try to evade or break.

Remember that the Pony Club motto is “loyalty, character and sportsmanship” and the main aim of Rally is enjoyment and pride in horsemanship and riding.
