Quiz Competition Levels: Members may compete at a level higher than their Pony Club level, but NOT lower, and cannot compete lower than a previous year.

Competitors should not be competing at E Open for Quiz more than once – E Jr is available to young members.

- A/B open to any testing level. This is the most difficult level. The 4 highest placing participants will be invited to compete at National Quiz 2025 which will be hosted in Alberta over Thanksgiving weekend.
- C open to testing level C2, and below. The 4 highest placing participants will be invited to compete at National Quiz 2025 (National competitors must be 12yrs old as of Jan 1st, 2025)
- D2 open to D2 and below.
- **D1 open** to **D1** and below. These will have the same questions as D2.
- **D** open to **D** and below. These will have the same questions as the D1 and D2.
- **E OPEN** open to E's of any age. i.e. new members or those who have never tested.
- **E JUNIOR*** open only to E's who were under 10 years of age as of January 1, 2025, and who are not comfortable competing with older children. This modified E test will have fewer questions and will not be included in the point tally for overall club awards.

Regional Quiz Entry Information for Individuals:

- Entry fee for 2025 is \$25 per member. Deadline for club entries is February 22nd, 2025 No late entries accepted.
- Complete one Individual Entry form for each competitor Sign and submit with a cheque to your club.
- Parent or guardian volunteers: Review the Volunteer Job Descriptions list and select a first and second choice volunteer job. Each entry must have at least one volunteer listed, preferred positions are not guaranteed.
 ALL volunteers MUST have a volunteer membership on file with Canadian Pony Club and have at minimum Level 1 screening.

Jr ID & Pictures Organizer	Times rotations, ensure groups move on to next table, maintain quiet, watch for cheating	None	2
Tutor/Scribe	Assists competitors in reading/writing for the tests.	None	As re- quested
Runner	Carries finished tests to the Marking/Scoring room (and anything else as required).	None	6 (AM or PM)
Senior ID Tables Scorer	Supervises visual ID table with a partner; scores previous test while current participants are writing.	None	12
Senior ID Table Room Supervisor	Times rotations, ensure groups move on to next table, maintain quiet, watch for cheating	None	2
Sorter	Sorts completed tests into branch/competitor order	None	5
Marker	Marks tests using an answer key. Some Pony Club knowledge would be helpful.	Accuracy, judiciousness	20
Marking Room Lead	Takes leadership over marking room, offers support to markers and can ask for TD as needed for clarifications.	Good PC Knowledge	2
Games Room Supervisor	Monitors games in a room and ensures groups move on to correct game in a timely fashion.	Leadership skills	2
Games Scorer	Runs and scores a game, on your own or with a partner.	Patience, fairness	9
