For jumper rounds, there will be two rounds in the morning, and 2 rounds in the afternoon. Only the best 3 rounds will count. 4 clear rounds will always beat 3 clear rounds and one with a penalty, regardless of time. In the case of a tie, combined jumping times closest to the optimum time from the best 3 rounds will decide the winner.

**No riders above C2** may compete in the 0.75 m (2'6") medal class.

Teams are made up of 3 horse/rider combinations *or* 3 pony/rider combinations, competing in any class open to them, however there will be NO mixing of horse and pony riders.

Please note your preference of team members on the entry form. If you have no preference, we will try and put you on a team

**Don't forget- To enter a championship division, you must qualify. In the preceding calendar year, you must have taken part in an EC/CPC show or event of equal height or difficulty to the division you wish to enter.**

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entry is open to all British Columbia CPC members in good standing. Completed Pony Club passports must be presented at registration.
2. The committee will follow the 2009 CPC Show Jumping rules. The show committee may cancel any class with insufficient entries or divide a class with excessive entries.
3. Either a horse or a pony may be used in the 0.58m (2') class. Horses will be scored as part of the horse division, and ponies as part of the pony division.
4. **No riders above C2 may compete in the 0.58m(2'6") medal class.**
5. No division changes allowed after the closing date. Horse substitutions are allowed up to 3 days before the show with DC's approval.
5. There will be no separate team rounds. Team score will be calculated from the best scores from individual results. 3 horse/rider **or** 3 pony/rider combinations per team, top 2 scores will count. No mixed horse/pony teams.
6. Coaching is allowed. Coaches must adhere to page 16 of the CPC Show Jumping Rules. Coaching riders who are on course will constitute outside assistance, and may result in elimination.
7. Ponies may be subject to measurement.
8. Riders are expected to be correctly and neatly attired as specified by Pony Club rules. **ASTM helmets** with a permanently attached harness, and **boots with a heel** are mandatory.
9. Any safe half chaps allowed for D & D1. D2 level and higher may wear half-chaps, but these must be smooth leather. Half chaps must be zippered.
10. **Medical armbands** must be worn at all times while mounted.
11. Show numbers to be worn at all times while mounted.
12. Mandatory tack check **before** morning **and** afternoon rounds. Failure to do this will result in rounds not scoring towards awards. It is the **competitor's responsibility** to present to tack check in a timely manner.
13. Awards will be presented after all divisions are completed. Full dress for awards ceremony please. **Awards will be UNMOUNTED**
14. No dogs allowed on the show grounds
