Thank you to Tamara Booy and Shannon Daly for all the riding lessons in January and the ones in February. We look forward to also seeing them during the Winter Program.








## SPC Badge Program - February

### Blankets and Bandaging

### **Objectives**

Members should be able to identify and put on basic bandages and blankets. They should know when to use them, how to care for them, basic materials used, etc.

### Attended Mini Workshop Saturday, Feb 4 @ Lauder Ranch

### **Bandages**

Members should be able to identify stable, shipping or travel, and tail bandages and be able to put them on correctly and safely. They should also have a basic knowledge of some first aid bandages such as spider and figure 8. They should understand when these bandages should be used, what their purpose is and when they are not suitable. They should know the problems if bandages are not put on correctly and the dangers of misusing them.

### **Blankets**

Members should be able to put on and take off a blanket correctly and safely. They should be able to identify and know the correct use for the following:

- Summer sheet.
- Cooler (wool or cotton mesh)
- Winter turnout
- Stable blanket (indoor)

They should learn about the fitting of blankets and the choice of the correct type for the conditions. They should know about care such as washing and mending, and the possible problems encountered when horses are turned out in blankets.

### Completion

To earn badge members will need to complete the following:

- 1. Complete online Bandaging questionnaire (link will be sent out next week); and
- 2. Attend in person and demonstrate your blanketing knowledge as outlined above. In the alternative, members may submit a video. The video should include them putting the blanket on and off their horse, and show their knowledge of blanketing as outlined above.

## Riders to Watch



### **Charlotte Fry**

Charlotte was born in Britain and is the daughter of Laura Fry, a competitor at the 1992 Barcelona Olympics. With horses as her roots, Charlotte began training at age 14 with Olympic Champion Carl Hester. Charlotte now trains with Anne van Olst and although based in the Netherlands she still often rides with Team Britain.

Anne says of Charlotte: "It takes time to ascertain whether someone has talent. There is a big difference between sitting nicely on a horse or having talent. But she certainly has talent. She is also a hare worker and has a lot of perseverance..."

For Charlotte, Anne is also her mentor. "What I also value is that Anne is so meticulous when it comes to the basic training work. For example the halt and making good use of the corners are things to which that she always pays attention."

Charlotte's many accomplishments include:

- Named the Peden Bloodstock FEI Best Athlete of 2022;
- Bronze Medal Tokyo Olympics Team Britain;
- Gold Medal 2022 World Championships, Individual;
- Gold Medal 2022 World Championships, Individual Freestyle;
- Silver Medal 2022 World Championships, Team Britain;
- Silver Medal 2021 European Championships, Team Britain; and
- 2021 & 2018 Gold Medals World Championships for Young Dressage Horses, Individual.
