Our membership drive for renewal or purchase of membership for the Springbank Pony Club will be in November.




Current members along with new members wanting to join will be sent all the information for their 2023 membership.

#### **Charlotte Dujardin**

Charlotte is a British dressage rider, equestrian, and writer. She has won multiple World and Olympic championships during her career. She won the 2022 World FEI Championship in Dressage. The kids were able to watch some of her performance, along with coach Kim Vos, this summer during camp.

Charlotte began riding at the age of two. She was also a member of the British Pony Club. At the age of three she won 2<sup>nd</sup> place at her first Pony Club show jumping competition.

## SPC Badge Program - October

#### **Objectives**
