#### GENERAL INFORMATION

The Canadian Pony Club Awards of Excellence are financial scholarships funded partially by the patron's fund of the Canadian Pony Club. Four awards will be given out to Pony Club members who exemplify the aims and objectives of Pony Club.

#### **CRITERIA**

You <u>must</u> be an active member with the Canadian Pony Club, and you <u>must</u> be attending a University or College in order to be eligible for this award, both at the time of applying and when the scholarships are awarded in April.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of the information contained in their application and their letters of reference.

The following areas will carry the most weight.

#### 1. \$1,200.00 Scholarship #1

- 1) Participation in instruction and testing at both the Club and Regional levels.
- 2) Participation in Club and Regional activities.
- 3) Candidates must have achieved at least an HB2 level or higher.

#### 2. \$800.00 Scholarship #2

- 1) Participation in instruction at the Club level and testing the D levels
- 2) Participate in Club and Regional Activities
- 3) Candidates must have achieved a C2 SM level or higher
- 4) Candidates must have been members of CPC for at least 3 years.

#### 3. \$500.00 Scholarship #3

- 1) Participation in Club and Regional activities.
- 2) Candidates must have achieved at least a C SM level or higher.
- 3) Candidates must have been members of CPC for at least 3 years.

Beginning in 2019, there will be an additional scholarship awarded using the same criteria as #3. This scholarship will be made up of the extra money in the Phil Crowe Memorial Fund and will pay out an extra \$500 until the fund runs out. There should be enough funds available to last 5-7 years, thanks to the many generous people who donated to the fund in Phil's name.
